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No	Question	Answer
1.	It is stated on page 12 of the Guidelines that Actions must take place in the Republic of Serbia. Does that mean a study visit to another country with Serbian participants would be deemed ineligible?	According to the Guidelines for Applicants, article 2.2.4. and article 2.2.8. <i>“To ensure equal treatment of applicants, the contracting authority cannot give a prior opinion on the eligibility of lead applicants, co-applicants, affiliated entity(ies), an action or specific activities.”</i>
2.	Are there any limitations regarding one organization being awarded grants as a co-applicant on two different proposals (for example, an NGO applying as a co-applicant twice: under LOT 1 and then again under LOT 2)?	The GfA under the paragraph <u>Number of applications and grants per applicants / affiliated entities</u> , states the following: <i>“The lead applicant may not be awarded more than (one) 1 grant under this Call for Proposals. The lead applicant <u>may be a co-applicant or an affiliated entity in another application at the same time.</u> A co-applicant/affiliated entity may not be awarded more than two (2) grants under this Call for Proposals.”</i> Consequently, one entity may be awarded 1 grant as Lead Applicant, and not more than 2 grants as co-applicant/affiliated entity.
